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RIDER TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF JILL JUST WANTS 2 HELP

The Corporation is incorporated under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the following purposes: The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws of the United States. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the purposes for which the Corporation is formed include: (1) to fund cancer research; (2) to provide assistance to low-income families that are battling illnesses such as cancer; and (3) to raise awareness of Shwachmann-Diamond Syndrome.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its officers or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes. Except as may be permitted under the provisions of Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws of the United States, no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the preparation or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Untied States Internal revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
